

OUTSIDE/LIVE WORK PROJECTS

The Waldo County Technical Center mission is to provide "hands-on" learning experiences for the students in the programs. The owner of the work project will provide all necessary materials. The Waldo County Technical Center will perform all practical labor, when possible, at no charge.
