

PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION IN DAY PROGRAMS

- A. High school students will be accepted from the partner schools based on the following established quota system:

The established quota system is based on the percentage figure used for assessment purposes from each partner district. The percentages are determined yearly based on the total enrollment (grades 9-12) from the partner schools preceding October 1 enrollment.

- B. Quota system as described in Section A above will be used until the annual April guidance meeting of Waldo County Technical Center's Student Service Coordinator, RSU # 20 guidance department and RSU # 3 guidance department. After the April guidance meeting, admission decisions regarding students enrolled at Belfast, Mt. View and Searsport High Schools will be made on a first come first serve basis
- C. If the individual program offerings have not been filled by the quota system by the third Thursday in September, the vacant slot(s) may be filled in priority order as follows:
1. Non-grad Region Seven Adult Ed Students (age 16-20);
  2. Non-grad Region Seven homeschoolers (age 16-20);
  3. Region Seven private school students;
  4. *Post-grad Region Seven (age 18-20);*
  5. *Non-grad non-Region Seven homeschoolers;*
  6. *Non-grad private non-Region Seven students;*
  7. Post-grad non-Region Seven;
  8. Adults Region Seven (over 20 years old);
  9. Adults (non-Region Seven)

All students must register through the local partner school

Students identified in Section C are required to submit an application and letter of intent to attend Waldo County Technical Center. Perspective students will be interviewed by a committee prior to acceptance into a program. The interview committee will include the program instructor and WCTC administration.

*NOTE: As of October 19, 2000 the Region 7 Cooperative Board authorized WCTC to charge 20 percent of the state average cost for educating a high school student for non region seven home schoolers and private school students as well as adults.*
